IS SOME 5-6 METRES.

AT SOME 500 FT MILE THE PATH CROSSES TOTTBURN LANE THE SURFACE
IS GOOD SOME PARTS GRADED WITH STONE.

RT6C THEN JOINS THE B4455 ON A GOOD HARD PACKED SURFACE
TAKING A BEARING ON RT6C SOME 500 FT MILE.

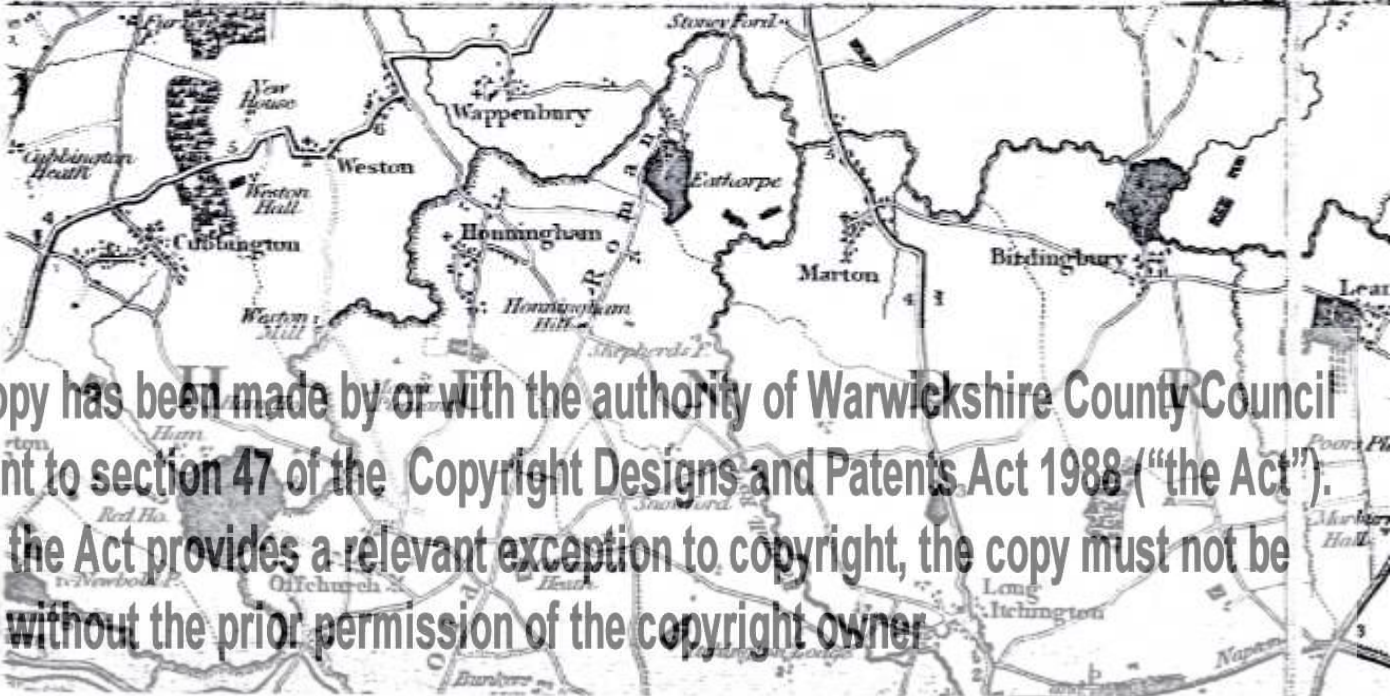
