modifying the Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Warwick by **Upgrading -**

Description :

SB17 leaves the county road C98 at Grid Ref: 2338-5443 in a north easterly direction for ~~some~~ 200 metres. The surface is of gravel and some 20 to 25 feet wide. It then turns **right** along the side of a hedge, then curves in an easterly direction. The surface now becomes more **padded** grass and stone until it reaches the county road E6329 and D6329 where it is tarmac. The whole route maintains its 20 to 25 foot width and is well defined throughout by obvious use and by hedges and tree lines. The total length of SB17 is 1.1 k.metre.

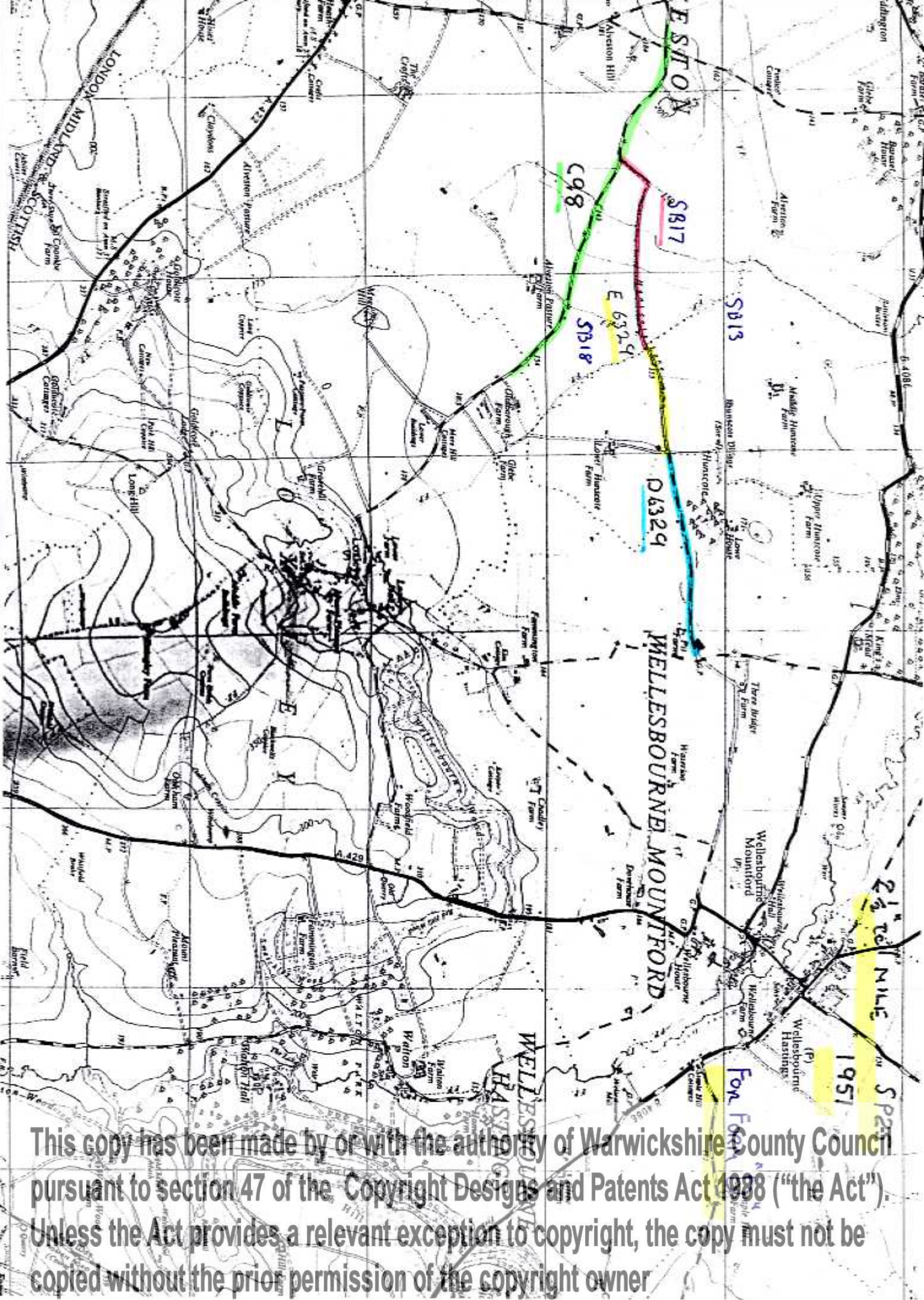
