The lane starts off as a gravel path but then becomes completely overgrown with vegetation and encroaching hedges and would be some 5 metres wide. The junction with SD342 is about half way along its length, there are three marker posts. N.B. SD341 was known as Twin Lane in the 1920's.

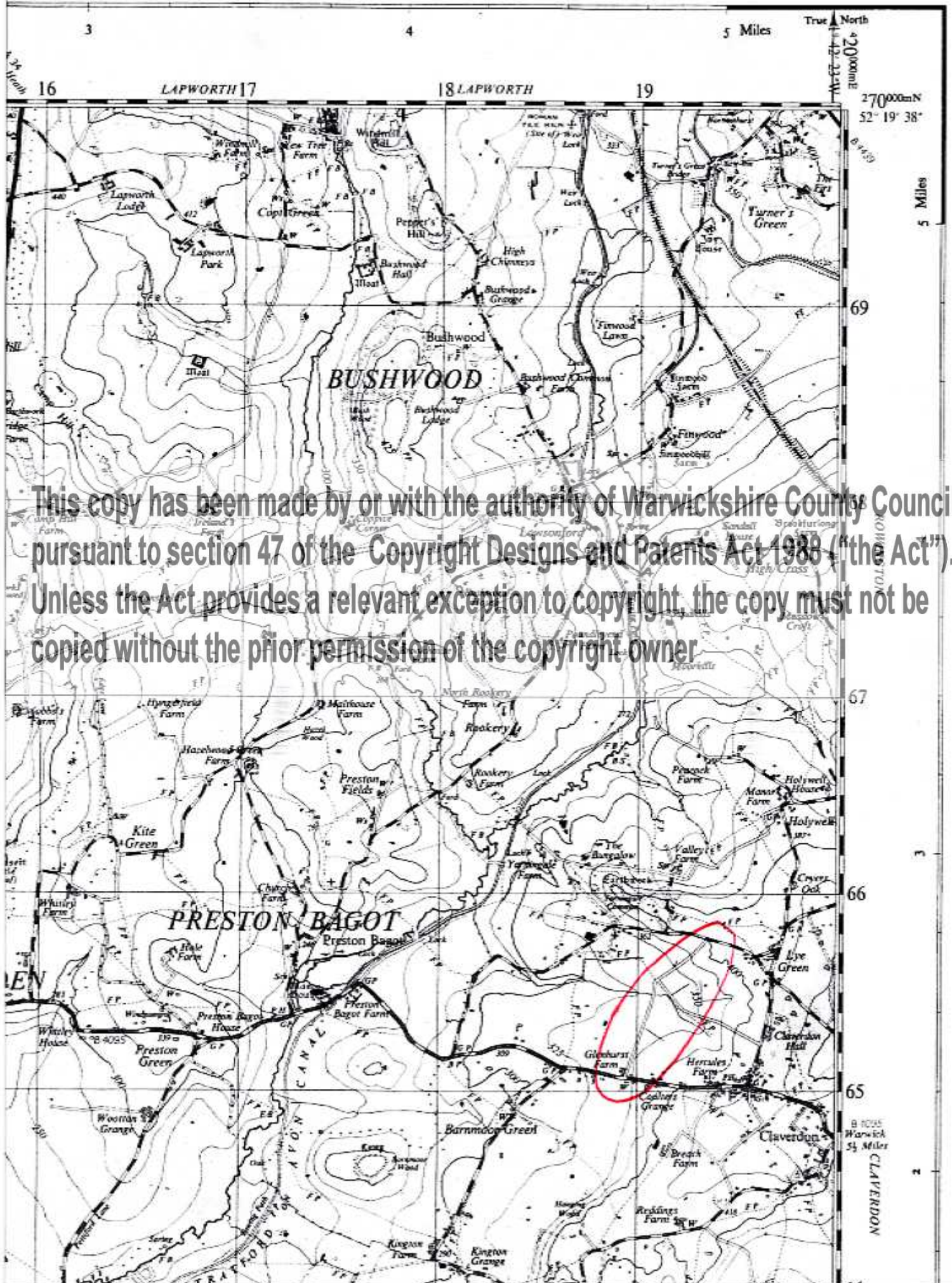
