Description: FROM BUTLEAS MISTON DOWN A SEALED ROAD THROUGH A GATE TO WATER PROCESS PLANT 500 METRES SEALED ROAD GIVESWAY TO WELL DEFINED TRACK, HEDGED ON EACH SIDE. CONTINUES AS A HEDGED LANE SOME 4 METRES WIDE 800 METRES HIGH DIRT LEE IN TRACK JOINS WITH SS3E FOR 450 METRES TO OXHOUSE FARM. HEDGED LANE CONTINUES PAST OXHOUSE FARM FOR 400 METRES TO THE JUNCTION WITH THE B4455 FOSSIE WAY AVAILABLE WIDTH 4 TO 5 METRES TOTAL LENGTH SOME 2.5 KILOMETRES. OBVIOUS VEHICULAR USE. PLEASE SEE ENCLOSED PICTURES FOR DETAIL.

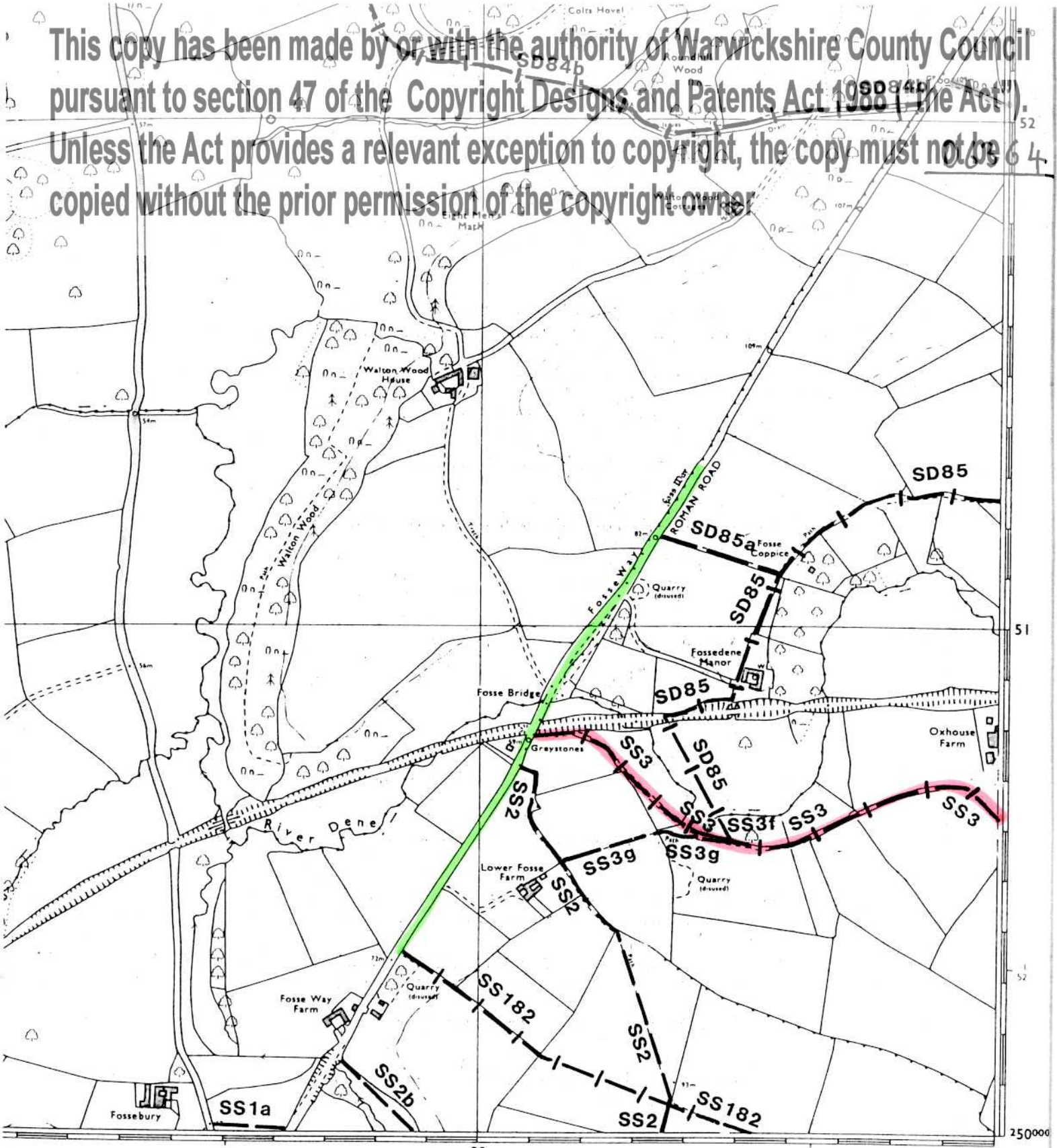
