I hereby apply for an Order under Section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981
modifying the Definitive Map and Statoment for the County of Warwick by **Upgrading** -

W149 on SP37SE from the north it is a continuation of the county road D2226. It continues in a south easterly direction from Grid Ref. 3767 7154 for 800 metres to its junction with R336 C.R.F. and the county road D2189 at Grid Ref. 3809 7096, then south for a further 750 metres to the county road B4453 at Grid Ref. 3816 7036

The route from Pagets Lane to R336 is a well defined track some 5 metres wide with a hard stone and tarmaced surface through woodland, there is a gate towards the D2226 end. The route from Nunwood Lane to the county road B4453 is again well defined, it is some 5 metres wide, mostly through woodland but with an area with open fields in places. The surface is hard packed stone, overgrown by grass in places. There are four gates along this part of W149.

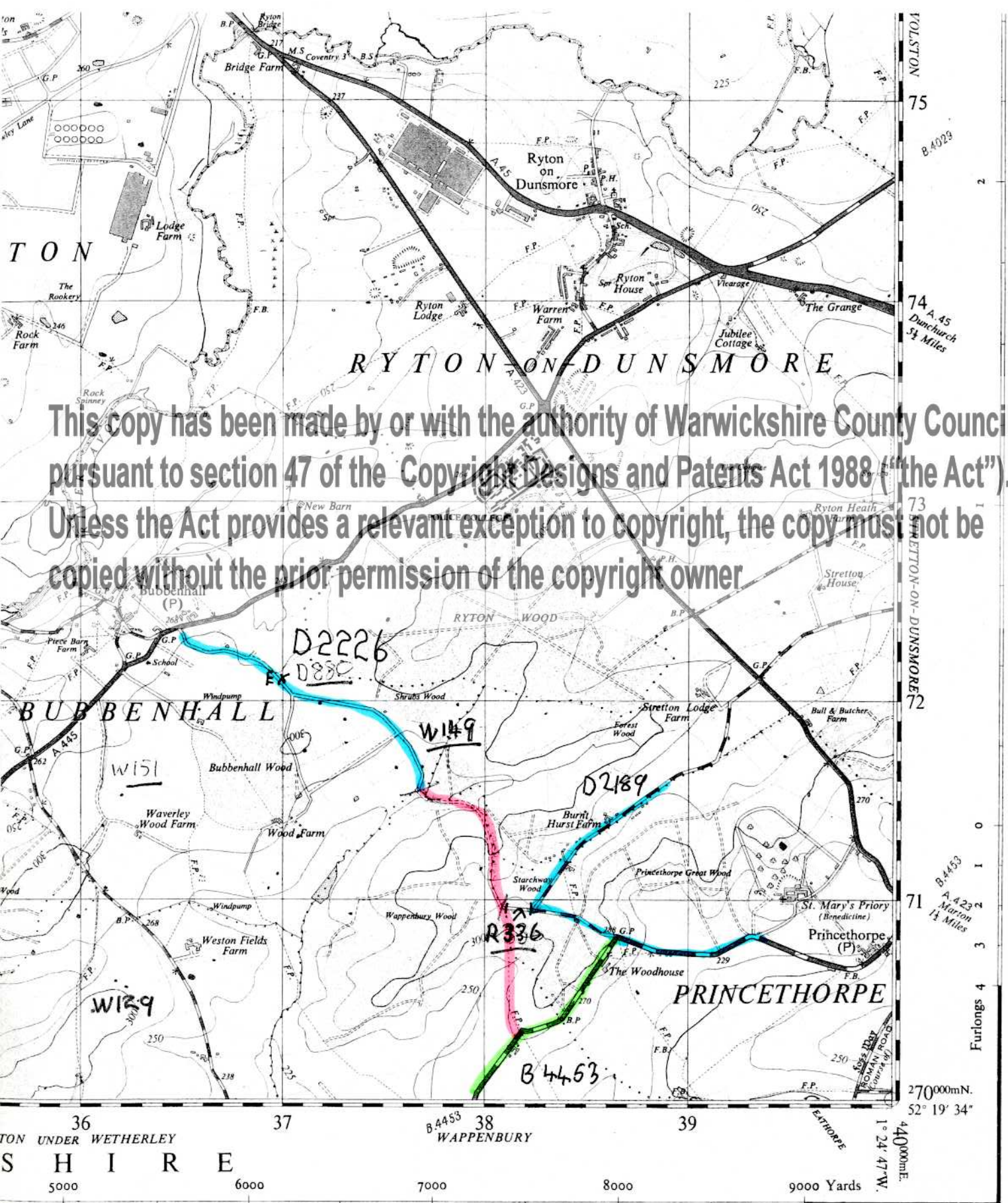
