

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH AE133  
ANSLEY/MANCETTER**

Warwickshire County Council **made** a Temporary Traffic Order details as indicated below:

<b>Effect of Order</b>	Public Footpath AE133 closed to <u>ALL</u> traffic at Grid references 42974 29399.
<b>Reason for Order</b>	To avoid the likelihood of danger to the public because of a collapsed bridge along its route.
<b>Order Effective from:</b> 16 July 2021 for up to 6 months and was due to expire on 15 January 2022. <b>However, the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under Section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has directed that the Order shall continue in force until 15 January 2023, or until completion of remedial works, whichever is the earlier (unless the Secretary of State issues a further direction).</b>	
<b>Access &amp; Diversion:</b> An alternative route will be signed.  Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of the highway to be closed, if any, will be maintained at all times.
