TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS N50 AND N18 IN THE PARISHES OF NUNEATON & BEDWORTH

Warwickshire County Council made a Temporary Traffic Order details as indicated below:

Effect of Order	Public Footpaths closed to All traffic as indicated below: N50 closed in its entirety (between N17 and N18) N18 closed between Grid References 432330.292508 (where N18 meets N6) and 432555.292557 (where N18 joins the dismantled railway path).
Reason for Order	To avoid the likelihood of danger to the public while development works are in progress
Order Effective from: 13 August 2021 for up to 6 months However, the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under Section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has directed that the Order shall continue in force until 12 February 2023 or until the works to which it relates are completed, whichever is the sooner (unless the secretary of State issues a further direction).
