THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH M67 BETWEEN COLESHILL TOWN AND THE PARISH OF MAXSTOKE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

<u>WHEREAS</u> the Warwickshire County Council ("the Council") as traffic authority for Public Footpath M67 between Coleshill Town and the Parish of Maxstoke is satisfied that traffic on the said footpath should be restricted by virtue of works proposed to be executed thereon or to avoid the likelihood of danger to the public

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This order shall come into operation on 22 February 2024 and may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (Public Footpath M67 between Coleshill Town and the Parish of Maxstoke) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2024".
- 2. No person shall use or permit to be used Public Footpath M67 between Coleshill Town and the Parish of Maxstoke at Grid Reference X420706 Y288956 for a period of 6 months commencing on 22 February 2024, or until the said works are completed, whichever is the earlier.
- 3. The provisions of Article 2 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs, as authorised by Section 64 of the said Act of 1984.
