## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS B2, B2A AND N45 ON THE BOUNDARY BETWEEN BEDWORTH & NUNEATON

Warwickshire County Council made a Temporary Traffic Order details as indicated below:

| <b>Effect of Order</b>   | <b>Public Footpaths B2, B2a And N45 on the boundary between Bedworth &amp; Nuneaton closed to ALL traffic at Grid Reference X434320 Y288168.</b> |
| <b>Reason for Order</b>  | To avoid the likelihood of danger to the public because of the dilapidated and dangerous condition of a bridge along their route.                |
| <b>Order Effective from:</b> 14 November 2023 for up to 6 months and was due to expire 13 May 2024. However, the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under Section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has directed that the Order shall continue in force until <b>13 November 2024</b> , or until works are completed, whichever is the earlier (unless the Secretary of State issues a further direction). |  |
| <b>Access &amp; Diversion:</b> Please find an alternative route via public footpaths. Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of the highway to be closed, if any, will be maintained at all times.   |  |
