



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH M67 BETWEEN COLESHILL TOWN AND THE PARISH OF MAXSTOKE**

Warwickshire County Council **made** a Temporary Traffic Order details as indicated below:

<b>Effect of Order</b>	Public Footpath M67 between Coleshill Town and the Parish of Maxstoke closed to ALL traffic at Grid Reference X420706 Y288956.
<b>Reason for Order</b>	To avoid the likelihood of danger to the public because serious defects have been identified in the bridge at this location that warrant further inspection and remedial works.
<b>Order Effective from:</b> 22 February 2024 and was due to expire 20 August 2024. However, the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under Section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has directed that the Order shall continue in force until 21 August 2026, or until remedial works are completed, whichever is the earlier (unless the Secretary of State issues a further direction).
