THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER

PARISH OF WISHAW SHEET SP 19 NE ORDER No. 1 2001 PATH No M463

This Order is made by Warwickshire County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to the authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Warwickshire 1998 require modification in consequence of an event specified in:

Section 53(3)(c)(i) of the Act:

That a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way to which this Part applies.

The authority have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. The Warwickshire County Council hereby order that:

- 1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date shall be 22nd February 2001
- 2. The Definitive Map and Statement for Warwickshire 1998 Sheet SP 19 NE shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
- 3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Warwickshire County Council Definitive Map Modification Order, Parish of Wishaw, Sheet SP 19 NE Order No. 1 2001 Path No M463

SCHEDULE PART I

MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE MAP SHEET SP 19 NE ORDER No. 1 2001

Description of path or way to be added

A bridleway, in the District of North Warwickshire and the Parish of Wishaw, shown as a solid black line on the plan reference SCG/Z507/1 annexed hereto. It starts from a point on the C10 Holly Lane, labelled point A, a point approximately 35 metres north-east of the junction between Lindridge Road and Holly Lane, grid reference SP 15939602. It runs south-eastwards for approximately 360 metres, then east-north-eastwards for approximately 325 metres, then generally east-south-eastwards for approximately 1010 metres, crossing footpath M1 to terminate on the D373 Grove Lane at point B, a point approximately 20 metres to the west of the fork in the eastern end of Grove Lane, grid reference SP 17419546. Width 2.4 metres.

On 23rd December 2002 the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs confirmed the above named Order as made.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to:

Add a public bridleway, in the District of North Warwickshire and the Parish of Wishaw, shown as a solid black line on plan reference SCG/Z507/1 to the Definitive Map and Statement for Warwickshire. It starts from a point on the C10 Holly Lane, labelled point A, a point about 35 metres north-east of the junction between Lindridge Road and Holly Lane, grid reference SP 15939602. It runs south-eastwards for about 360 metres, then east-north-eastwards for about 325 metres, then generally east-south-eastwards for about 1010 metres, crossing public footpath M1 to join the D373 Grove Lane at point B, about 20 metres west of its fork, grid reference SP 17419546. Width 2.4 metres.

The Order became operative as from 23rd December 2002 but if any person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, or that any of the requirements of Schedule 15 of that Act have not been complied with may, within 42 days from 16th January 2003, make an application to the High Court under paragraph 12 of the said Schedule 15.
