## **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF**

## PUBLIC FOOTPATH R154/3 IN THE PARISH OF STRETTON ON DUNSMORE

Warwickshire County Council <u>made</u> a Temporary Traffic Order details as indicated below:

Effect Order	of	Public Footpath R154/3in the Parish of Stretton on Dunsmore closed to all traffic between Grid Reference SP 40513 73082 (junction of Public Footpaths 277/R154/3 and 277/R154b/1) and SP 40804 72966 (junction of Public Footpath 277/R154/3 and Hill Crescent).
Reason Order	for	To avoid the likelihood of danger to the public because works are being carried out on or near to the footpath

Order Effective from: 1 March 2025 for up to 6 months and was due to expire 31 August 2025. However, the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under Section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has directed that the Order shall continue in force until **1 September 2026**, or until works are completed, whichever is the earlier (unless the Secretary of State issues a further direction).
