**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF
PUBLIC FOOTPATH N36 NUNEATON & BEDWORTH**

Warwickshire County Council **made** a Temporary Traffic Order details as indicated below:

Effect of Order	Public Footpath N36 Nuneaton & Bedworth closed to ALL traffic from Grid references X437763 Y291121 to X438204 Y291073.
Reason for Order	Because construction works are being carried out on or near to the footpath.
<p>Order Effective from: 14 July 2022 and was due to expire on 13 January 2025. However, the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under Section 15(5) of The Road Traffic Act 1984 has now directed that the Order shall continue in force until 31 December 2027 or until completion of the works, whichever is the earlier (unless the Secretary of State issues a further direction).</p>	
<p>Access & Diversion: An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Crowhill Road, Public Bridleway N39 and a permissive section over land owned by the developer.</p> <p>Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of the highway to be closed, if any, will be maintained at all times.</p>
