TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC BYWAY M450 CURDWORTH/WISHAW

On 1 August 2006 Warwickshire County Council made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Public Byway M450 to all traffic between points B and C on the plan (from where it crosses the M42 motorway, along Marston Lane to the junction with A4097 Kingsbury Road) and closing Public Byway M450 to all traffic with the exception of pedestrians between points A and B on the plan (between its junctions with Public Footpath M13 and the A446 Lichfield Road).

Reason for Closure	The closure was required in the interests of public safety.

The Order commenced on 7 August 2006 and following directions of the Secretary of State was due to expire on 6 August 2025. However, the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has further directed the Order shall continue in force until the works to which it relates have been completed, or until 6 August 2028, whichever is the sooner.

Access & Diversion:

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of public byway to be closed, if any, will be maintained.
