Warwickshire County Council **made** a Temporary Traffic Order details as indicated below:

Effect of Order	Public Footpaths B43 Bedworth and R37 Shilton & Barnacle closed to ALL traffic AT Grid Reference X439699 Y285341.
Reason for Order	To avoid the likelihood of danger to the public because of a collapsed bridge along their route.
