

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS B8 AND B9, BEDWORTH**

Warwickshire County Council **made** a Temporary Traffic Order details as indicated below:

<b>Effect of Order</b>	<p>Public Footpaths B8 and B9, Bedworth closed to all traffic as follows:</p> <p><b>Public Footpaths B8</b> Bedworth between Point P (GR N286160105 E43320581, Point N (GR 286130750 E43319371), Point E (GR N286099053 E433202386) Point D (GR286096800 E433189771) and Point M (GR N285920800 E433208851).</p> <p><b>Public Footpaths B9</b>, Bedworth between Point A (GR N286138970 E432969931), Point B (GR N286138800 E433026371), Point C (GRN286127959 E433119194), Point D (GRN286096800 E43318977), Point E (GR N286099053 E433202386), Point F (GRN2860086328 E433360163), Point G (GR N286086328 E433392514) Point H (GR N286098650 E433430021), Point J (GR N2186068202 E433562838), Point K (GR N286053586 E433557959) and Point L (GR N286049431 E433571431).</p>
<b>Reason for Order</b>	<p>Because construction works are being carried out on or near to the paths.</p>
<p><b>Order Effective from:</b> 27 October 2025 for up to 6 months and was due to expire on 26 April 2026. However, the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under Section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has directed that the Order shall continue in force until <b>26 April 2027</b>, or until works are completed, whichever is the earlier (unless the Secretary of State issues a further direction).</p>	
<p><b>Access &amp; Diversion:</b> The alternative routes will be using the local roads and the sections of B8 and B10 that are not closed.</p>
