**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF**

**PUBLIC FOOTPATH B25 IN THE PARISH OF BEDWORTH**

Warwickshire County Council **made** a Temporary Traffic Order details as indicated below:

<b>Effect of Order</b>	Public Footpath B25 in the Parish of Bedworth closed to all traffic between Grid References SP346842 - X(easting) 434627, Y(northing) 284229 and SP3345844 - X(easting) 434573, Y(northing) 284427
<b>Reason for Order</b>	For public safety while development works are in progress on or near to the path.
<b>Order Effective from:</b> 9 December 2025 and was due to expire 5 June 2026. However, the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under Section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has directed that the Order shall continue in force until <b>31 March 2028</b> or until works are completed, whichever is the earlier (unless the Secretary of State issues a further direction).
