



2021 Census data: Exploring ethnic group data in Warwickshire

Warwickshire is a more diverse county than in 2011 but compared to England and Wales, Warwickshire is less diverse in terms of its population make up.

Differing patterns of ageing, fertility, mortality and migration all contribute to ethnic composition. Additionally, changes may be because of the way individuals choose to identify between census periods.

High Level Ethnic Group Insights

The percentage of the population in all high level ethnic groups except 'White' increased since 2011.

The largest proportional increase was seen in people identifying as 'Asian', up from 4.6% in 2011 to 6.3% in 2021.

Ethnic group refers to the group that people completing the census feel they belong to. This could be based on culture, family background, identity or physical appearance. Respondents could choose one out of five higher level and then 19 more detailed tick-box response categories, including write-in response options.

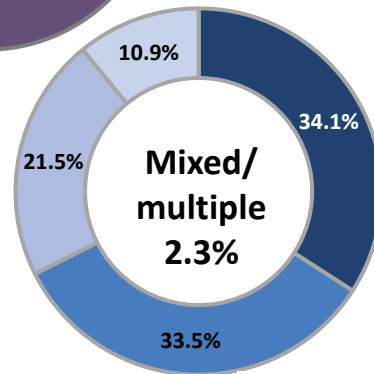
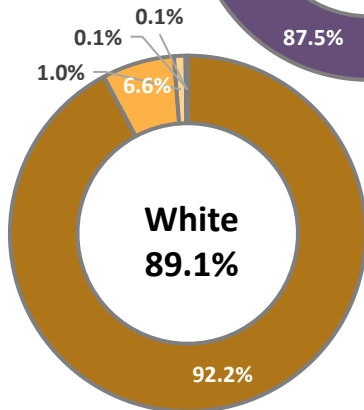
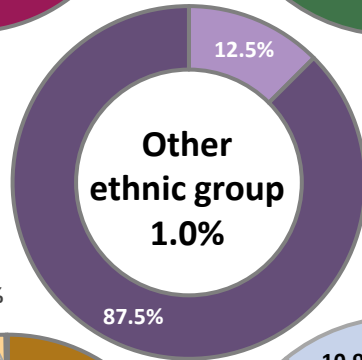
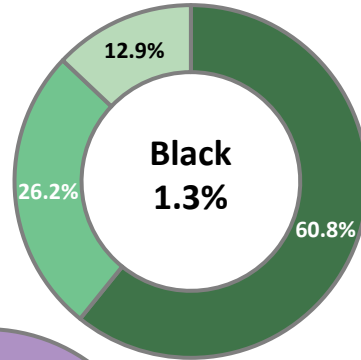
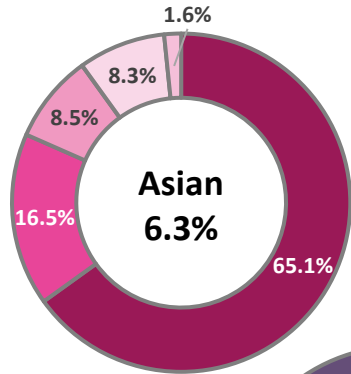


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Breakdown of the five higher level ethnic groups in Warwickshire

Detailed Level Ethnic Group Insights

5.9% of the total population identified as 'Other White'

An increase of 2.7 percentage points since 2011 to 35,025 people; the largest of any detailed ethnic group

4.1% of the total population as 'Indian'

An increase of 1.1 percentage points since 2011 to 24,290 people; it is higher than the national average of 3.1%

82.1% of the total population identified as 'English, Welsh, Scottish, Northern Irish or British'

Higher than the national average of 74.4% but a decline of 6.4 percentage points since 2011

Ethnic Group & Households



5.5% of households reported that ethnic groups differed within partnerships

Similar to the national average of 5.7%. An increase of 1.6 percentage points since 2011.

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
