Approximate distance: 54 miles / 86km

Start: Long Itchington
Follow A423 south to Southam
*Go into Southam if you want to explore the town trail (downloadable from <u>www.southam.co.uk</u>)

Take A426 **Optional detour – Draycote Water Park CV23 8AB* Continue on A426 **Dunchurch*

Continue on A426 *Rugby: Rugby School on right (CV22 5EH) Pick up A428 Barby Road (grounds where rugby football started; you can also park here) *Rugby School and museum; Rugby Art Gallery & Museum (CV21 3BZ) and World Rugby Hall of Fame; Webb Ellis Rugby Football Museum; Caldecott Park

Continue on A428 Hillmorton A428 Crick *Crick Marina, Grand Union Canal and Crick Tunnel NN6 7SQ

Back to centre of Crick village and take Church Street past the church. Then: Yelvertoft Road – Crick Road Yelvertoft Left onto High Street Cold Ashby Road Clay Coton Drive over A14 Stanford on Avon *St Nicholas' Church (corner of Stanford Road and South Kilworth Road) Stanford Road *Stanford Hall LE17 6DH

Continue on Stanford Road Swinford Rugby Road Under motorway Main Street – Rugby Road Catthorpe *Manor Farm Shop, Kitchen and Beer Barn LE17 6DB

Follow Rugby Road Cross A5 B5415 Newton Manor Lane Brownsover Left onto A426 *Elliott's Field Shopping Park CV21 ISR

Continue on B4112 A4071 Pass CEMEX Rugby Cement Plant on right Right turn onto A428 Long Lawford Church Lawford Left B4455 (Fosse Way) After driving under arched bridge, turn right onto Rugby Road Wolston Warwick Road Right onto A45 A45 Tollbar Island *Optional detour – left towards Baginton and Midland Air Museum CV3 4FR and The Lunt Roman Fort CV8 3AJ

Continue on to Coventry UK City of Culture (May 2021 to May 2022) A45 Right onto A429 (Kenilworth Road) War Memorial Park (park and ride) *Highlights in Coventry include Coventry Transport Museum CV1 1JD; Coventry Cathedral CV1 5AB; Herbert Art Gallery & Museum CV1 5QP
