

These tools can be accessed by clicking on the ReachDeck icon on the top right-hand side of Warwickshire County Council webpages highlighted in red below:

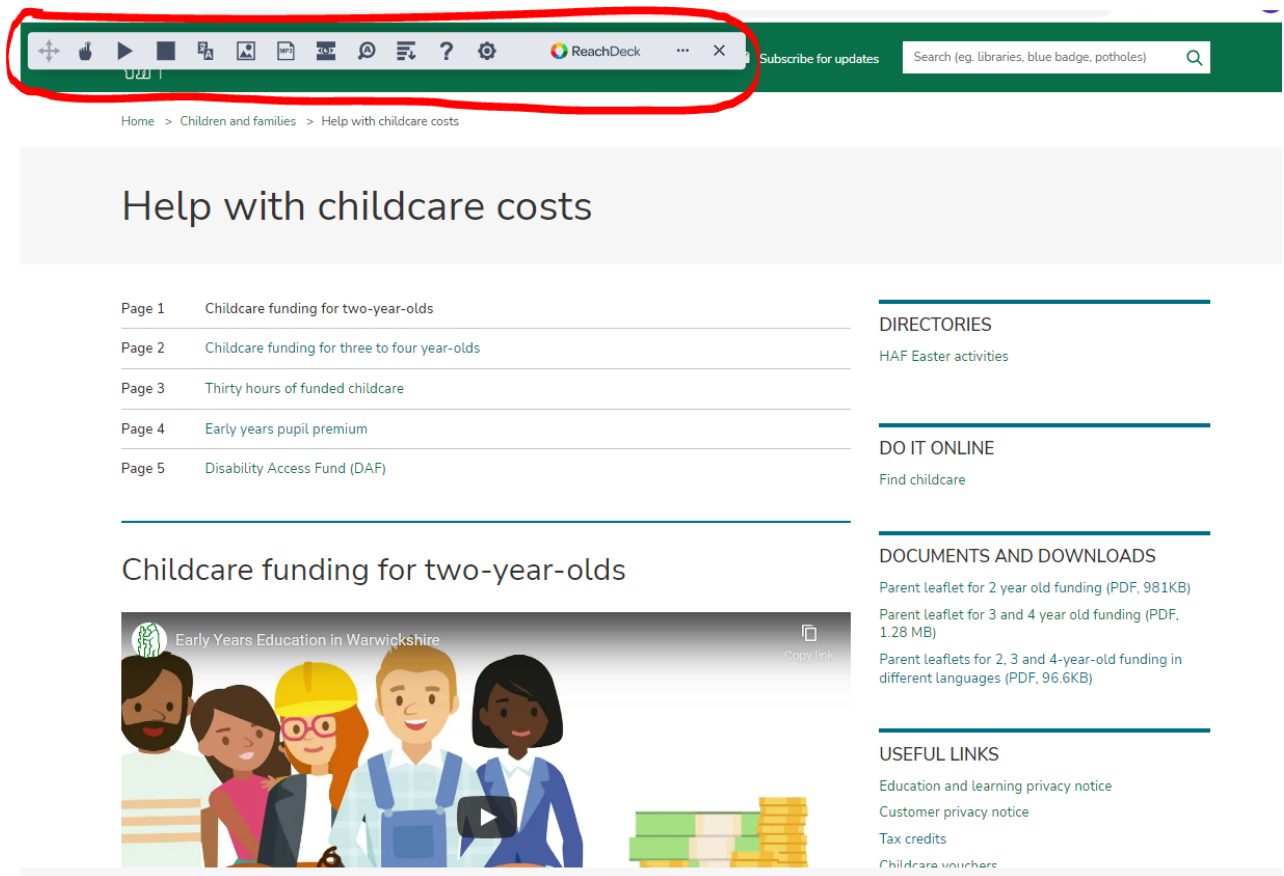

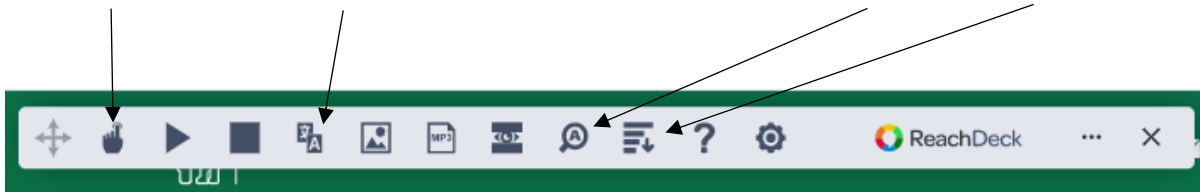

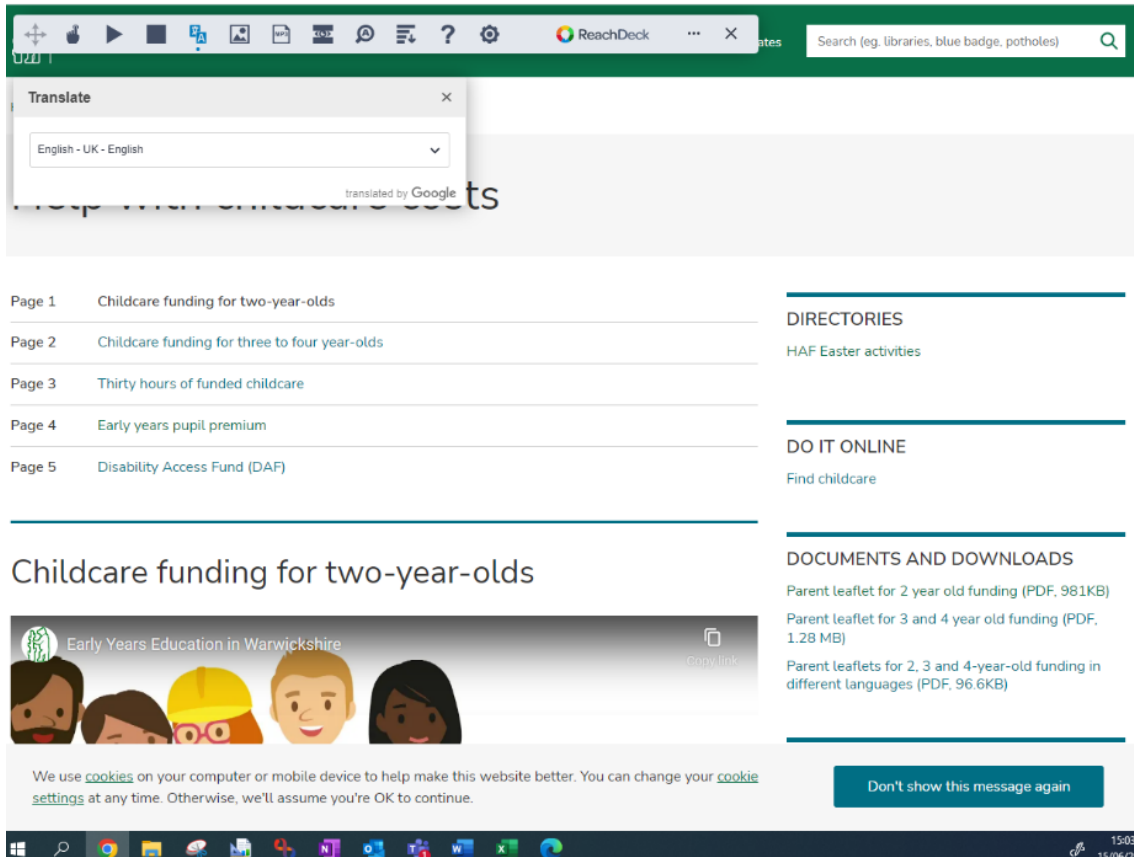


The toolbar contains a variety of icons which can be used to:
