#### Setting supporting Evidence for Inclusion Grant Application.

Inclusion Grant is funding to support enhancing ratios for children as they become established in their pre-school provision, showing emerging and significant need.

Inclusion Grant is for children in receipt of universal nursery 3 and 4 yr old early education entitlement and children in receipt of enhanced 30 hour early education entitlement. Inclusion Grant is also for children in receipt of 2HELP with complex physical needs requiring manual handling.

For 2 Year Olds in receipt of 2HELP with social interaction and SEMH needs, where the risk to the child or others is very significant and identified through a risk assessment, a single inclusion payment may be made, in consultation with IDS.

- The child will be referred to IDS 0-5 and attend a Warwickshire pre-school provision, regardless of home address.
- The child will have targets in place as part of an individualised Assess Plan Do Review cycle
- The setting will show secure Universal Provision. They will be Good or Outstanding. If a setting is Requires Improvement, individual decisions will be made. Inclusion Grant will only be allocated to settings which are deemed Inadequate in exceptional circumstances.
- The setting will complete the Supporting Evidence sheet and send it with a Teaching Talking Profile and, if not WlncKS, a copy of their universal provision matrix to: <a href="idsteachingandlearning@warwickshire.gov.uk">idsteachingandlearning@warwickshire.gov.uk</a> if they have secure email.
- Use of funding will be monitored by IDS
