WHAT IS HAF?




The Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme is funded by the **Department for Education** (DfE) to provide young people who are in fulltime education (Reception to Year 11) and eligible for benefits-related free school meals with access to enriching activities and meals, for free, during the three main school holidays: Winter, Spring and Summer.

Spring HAF: Monday 25th March – Friday 5th April 2024 (maximum of 4 sessions)
