Summer 2024 Warwickshire Holiday HAF **Activities &** Food (HAF) Programme

The Summer HAF delivery period ran from Monday 22nd July - Friday 30th August 2024. Each eligible young person can access a maximum of 16 funded sessions over the school holiday.

The Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) provision in Warwickshire is for children in full time education from reception to Year 11 (inclusive), who receive benefitsrelated free school meals (FSM).

The programme offers valuable support to families on lower incomes, giving young people the opportunity to access activities with a meal provision over the main school holidays in Winter, Spring and Summer.



"Just wanted to say, our son suffers from ADHD and often struggles with clubs but this one he couldn't wait to attend and be a part of. The staff are so mature and understanding, it was nice being able to leave him and know that I hadn't got to worry. 

Activities on offer ranged from arts & crafts, multi-sport, animal care, boxing, BMX, football, performing arts and music. We also fund closed provisions with internal council teams like resettlement.







8,000 HAF codes have been sent out to date. This amounts to more than **1/3 of those eligible** for FSM in Warwickshire.




