Warwickshire Spring 2025 Holiday HAF **Activities &** Food (HAF) Programme

The Spring HAF delivery period ran from Saturday 12th April - Sunday 27th April 2025. Each eligible young person could access a maximum of 4 funded sessions over the school holiday.

The Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) provision in Warwickshire is for children in full time education from reception to Year 11 (inclusive), who receive benefitsrelated free school meals (FSM).

The programme offers valuable support to families on lower incomes, giving young people the opportunity to access activities with a meal provision over the main school holidays in Winter, Spring and Summer.



The overall **non-attendance** figure for Spring HAF was 6%. This is lower than the non-attendance figure of 8.5% from Spring HAF 2024. Direct, activity-to-family communication and consistent follow-up efforts by our dedicated providers are key to ensuring HAF placements are filled.

Over **8,600** HAF codes have been sent out to date. This amounts to more than **1/3 of** those eligible for FSM in Warwickshire.

Activities on offer ranged from multi-sport to STEM, theatre, animal care, boxing, football, music and arts. We also fund closed provisions with internal council teams like resettlement.






