


Logging into WILMa using Google

Single sign on for WILMa has been implemented for all WCC users who have a Google account. This means you will no longer have to enter your username and password to access WILMa.


You can still access WILMa from the icon on your desktop or via the following link - [WILMa](#)

If you have a WCC Google account you should now log into WILMa by clicking on the 'Sign-in with Google' button which is displayed on the WILMa login screen shown below. **Please ensure you are logged into your WCC Google account using the same browser that you are accessing WILMa from before attempting to login to WILMa.** Please do not try and enter your WILMa username and password into the login screen as this will no longer work:


You will **not** be asked to enter a username or password. The first time you login using this option the following screen will appear, please click 'Allow'

The site has an updated look and feel but you can continue to use WILMa as normal.

You can also 'Log out' of WILMa by selecting the option displayed in the above box. Selecting 'Log out' will also log you out of your Google account on the device you are working on.

Please note:

You **MUST** always log out of WILMa if you are using a non WCC or unencrypted device.
