

THE INTEGRATED 2 YEAR DEVELOPMENTAL REVIEW



WHAT IS THE INTEGRATED REVIEW?

All children in England are offered a 2-2.5 year review as part of the Healthy Child Programme. This review is usually completed by your local Health Visiting team and is a chance to discuss all areas of your child's development and any concerns that you may have. It provides professionals with the opportunity to provide early intervention to support your child's individual needs.

If your child is in an Early Years Setting, an Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) Progress Check will be completed between 2-3 years of age.

An integrated review is when Warwickshire Health Visiting Teams and Warwickshire Early Years Providers work together to complete their assessments of your child, to support your child to be ready for school.



WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS FOR MY CHILD?

By working together, Warwickshire Health Visitors and Early Years Providers will be able to provide you with a holistic assessment of your child's development and ensure that your child's needs are met. If any additional support or referral to other agencies is needed, this can be completed at the time of the review, ensuring that your child receives the right support in a timely manner. By working together the Health Visiting Service and Early Years Providers can offer ongoing support, help and guidance to ensure that your child reaches their full potential and is ready for school.



HOW WILL THIS BE DONE?

You will be asked to sign a consent form to share information, by both your Health Visiting Team and your Early Years Provider that will allow them to share information with one another.

The Early Years setting will let the Health Visiting Team know that your child is attending their setting and will be due a 2-2.5 year review. The setting will assess your child using an integrated review development checklist & the outcome of this will be discussed with you, giving you opportunity to raise any concerns with them. The completed checklist is then emailed to the Health Visiting team prior to your child's 2-2.5 year review. Your child will have their review with the Health Visiting Team, where you will again be given opportunity to discuss the outcome and any concerns you may have. The outcome of this review will then be emailed back to the Early Years Provider & liaison takes place to support your child with any areas of need that may be identified.
