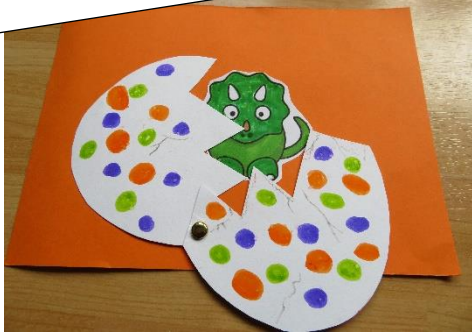


Dinosaurs

Draw an oval onto some white card, carefully cut it out, or an adult could help you. Then decorate the egg, go crazy if you want to and make it colourful.

Cut a zig zag through the middle of your shape. Glue a dinosaur onto a piece of paper (these can be found at the foot of this page)

With a paper fastener fix the two halves of the egg together. The two halves should open and close. Glue one half of the egg onto the paper. Now you have your own baby dinosaur.

What kind of dinosaur can you ride in a rodeo?

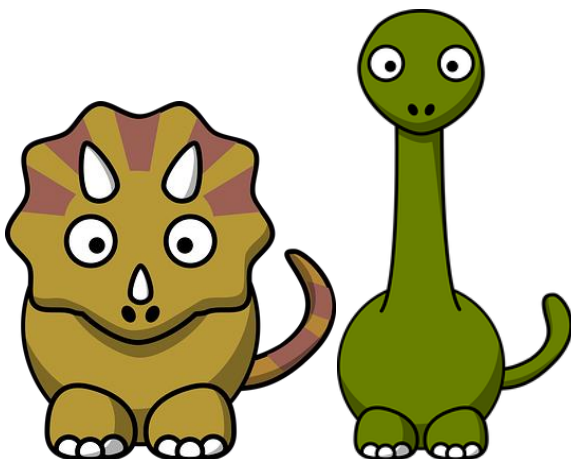
A Bronco-saurus!

Playdough Recipe

2 cups flour, 1 cup salt,
2 cups boiling water

2 tablespoons oil 2
teaspoons cream of
tartar

A few drops of food
colouring.

Mix all the ingredients
together in a bowl.

*(Please be careful
when using the boiling
water)*

Try adding some sand to the
playdough, for added texture.

Make an imaginary dinosaur world,
using greenery from outside.

***These are fun to create; you will need an
adult to help you.***

*Place a small toy dinosaur in a balloon and
fill with water.*

*Tie a knot in the top of the balloon and
place it in a box in the freezer. When set,
cut the neck of the balloon and pop the
egg out!*

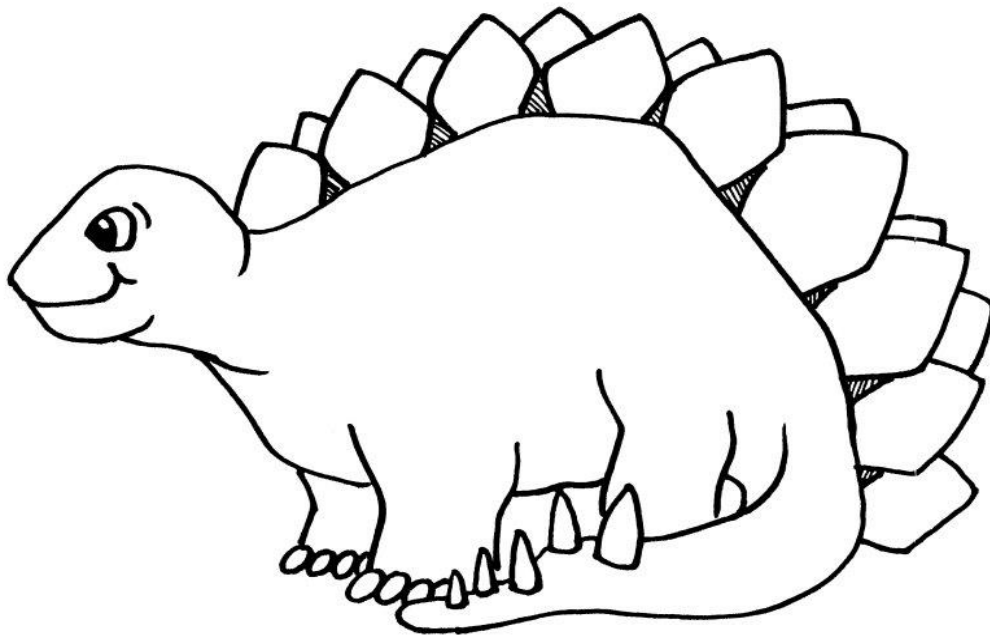
