
Weather

Easy to make wind sock

Take a rectangle piece of card and go crazy with stickers, pens or sequins to decorate. Tape some tissue paper streamers or re-cycle plastic bag strips to the bottom of the card. Roll into a tube and stick down with tape. Fix a piece of wool to the top of the tube.

The conductor!



Shadow Safari


