Redeveloped in 2017, this unique grade 2* listed 17th century landmark stands in the heart of Warwick, the county town of Warwickshire.

The 320,000 items in our collections include dinosaur fossils, Georgian clothing, tapestry, and jewellery. The range of distinctive spaces, alongside our friendly and dedicated staff, create an unforgettable event experience.

Reception & Cafe

A flexible space for greeting and entertaining guests, alongside the Warwickshire Bear and Giant Irish Deer.

Events can extend into the cafe, allowing guests exclusive access for the day or evening.

1836 to Present Day

A large flexible space, well suited to celebrations, drinks receptions, talks, and workshops.

The ground floor reflects the birth of the museum in 1836 to the present day, and displays our Giant Irish Deer skeleton, full-size replica of the Wilmcote Plesiosaur skeleton, and the Warwickshire Bear.

Ground floor capacity: 80



Anglo Saxon to 1836

A spacious open area, well suited to celebrations and drinks receptions.

This striking gallery space offers full-length views of the famous Sheldon Tapestry Map of Warwickshire, dating back to the 16th century.

Showcasing exquisite costume, historical musical instruments, and tools of the rich and poor, this room reflects Warwickshire living.

The First Museum

Alongside the Anglo Saxon to 1836 gallery, this intimate space displays a varied selection of eccentric items from the collections.

This gallery is a contemporary interpretation of the Warwickshire Natural History and Archaeological Society's Victorian museum, that was established at the Market Hall.

Origins to Romans

A large space well suited to celebrations and drinks receptions, with market square views.

This gallery has plenty to offer guests on the inside too. Displaying rocky origins from over half a billion years ago up to the Roman period, exhibits range from a fossilised Warwickshire dinosaur to a live bee hive.
