**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (FREER STREET, ATTLEBOROUGH,
NUNEATON) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) (VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 2019**

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to extend the existing one way traffic flow on Freer Street, Nuneaton to its entire length (between its junctions with The Green and Highfield Road).

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a copy of the Order to be varied, a plan showing the length of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick, at the Nuneaton & Bedworth Borough Council, Town Hall, Coton Road, Nuneaton and at the Library & Information Centre, Church Street, Nuneaton during usual opening hours.
