

LOXLEY ROAD, STRATFORD-UPON-AVON

Proposed 50 mph speed limit

1. STATEMENT OF REASONS

1. Warwickshire County Council is proposing to reduce a section of existing 50mph speed limit to 30mph by virtue of street lighting on Loxley Road, Stratford-upon-Avon.
2. The reduced speed limit has been requested by Design Services, Warwickshire County Council to ensure that vehicle speeds are reduced on the approach to a proposed new vehicular access to development on Loxley Road.
3. The scheme will involve the use of speed limit signs, road markings and gateway features. A reduced speed limit is proposed for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road to which the order relates.

2. SCHEDULE

SCHEDULE 1 (Proposed 50 mph)

1. Loxley Road

From a point 275 metres west of its junction with Goldicote Road, in a westerly direction to a point 80 metres west of its junction with Knights Lane.

3. EXISTING ORDERS TO BE AMENDED

1. The Warwickshire County council (Loxley Road/Stratford Road, Loxley Lane, Knights Lane, Pimlico Lane, Church Lane, Alveston, Kissing Tree Alveston, Alveston Hill, Hunscombe Lane and Charlescote Road) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 2016

2. Replace item (ii) of section 8 within the above order and replace with;

Loxley Road

(ii) From a point 275 metres west of its junction with Goldicote Road, in a westerly direction to a point 80 metres west of its junction with Knights Lane.
