Proposed 50 mph speed limit

1. STATEMENT OF REASONS

- 1. Warwickshire County Council is proposing to reduce a section of existing 50mph speed limit to 30mph by virtue of street lighting on Loxley Road, Stratford-upon-Avon.
- The reduced speed limit has been requested by Design Services, Warwickshire County Council to ensure that vehicle speeds are reduced on the approach to a proposed new vehicular access to development on Loxley Road.
- 3. The scheme will involve the use of speed limit signs, road markings and gateway features. A reduced speed limit is proposed for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road to which the order relates.
