SCHOOL LANE, WARMINGTON

Proposed One Way system and Prohibition of Right Turn movement

1. STATEMENT OF REASONS

- **1.1** Warwickshire County Council is proposing a One Way system on School Lane from its junction with B4100 Banbury Road to its junction with Chapel Street. In addition to that a prohibition of right turn to vehicles travelling northbound on B4100 Banbury Road into School Lane is proposed.
- **1.2** The scheme is proposed to allow safer movement of traffic along School Lane, where carriageway widths prevent two-way traffic from operating.
- **1.2** The scheme will involve the use of a new build-out (as a traffic calming feature), signs and road markings. The One Way system will improve road safety, by avoiding conflicts between opposing traffic and pedestrians due to tight geometrical layout of this road.

2. SCHEDULE

2.1 For clarity and avoidance of confusion, it should be read in conjunction with Plan No. TR10913/01 Proposed One Way system.

SCHEDULE 1 (One Way system)

1. School Lane

From its junction with B4100 Banbury Road to southeast length of 47 metres

SCHEDULE 2 (Prohibition of Right Turn)

2. <u>B4100 Banbury Road to School Lane</u>

The northbound vehicles on B4100 Banbury Road from turning right into School Lane

SCHEDULE 3 PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING FEATURE

3. <u>School Lane, Warmington</u> Proposed build-out (as a traffic calming feature) on the south side of School Lane, at its junction with Chapel Street.
