Then south for another 400 metres to join SD107 at grid ref 3410 5414. The surface is 4-5 metres wide part metalled and part open field fenced and hedged on one side. Total length some one kilometre.

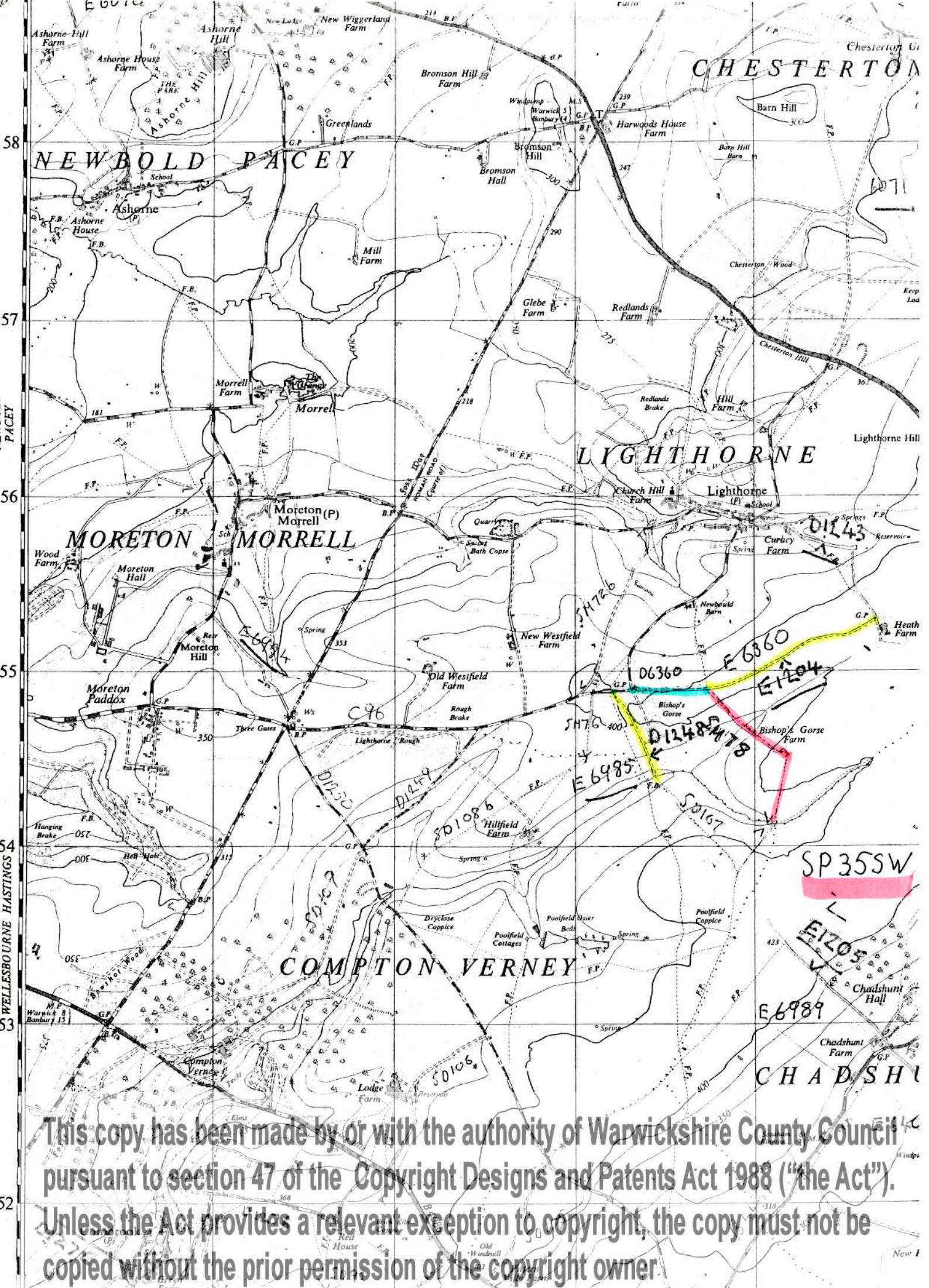
