I hereby apply for an Order under Section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Warwick by **Adding** the following route as a -

Public Footpath / Public Bridleway / Byway Open to All Traffic\*

The path begins at the rend of Duck Lane, Welford-M-Avon, where 8 concrete steps lead upwards from the Avon Valley Walk.

The route goes S.E towards Weston-on-Aron behind the houses on Orchard Nurseries.

The route finisher down 3 wooden steps to join path SD336. There are no obstructions, fences, shles or gales. The path is between 2-3ft wide or the surface is of grass vearth.
