I hereby apply for an Order under Section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Warwick by **Adding** the following route as a -

The path begins at the end of Duck Lane, Welford-on-Avon, where 8 concrete steps lead upwards from the Avon Valley Walk.

The route goes S.E towards Weston-on-Avon behind the houses on Orchard Nurseries.

The route finishes down 3 wooden steps to join path SD336. There are no obstructions, fences, stiles or gates. The path is between 2-3ft wide & the surface is of grass & earth.

Briefly, why do you believe this route is a public right of way?

As confirmed by the witnesses, this path has been used, unhindered, for at least 65 years.

As far back as 1969 Welford Parish Council suggested to Warwickshire County Council that this path be adopted.

The 1:250 Ordnance Survey map clearly shows that the path exists.

The Avon Valley Walk/Bridleway on the lower slope by the R. Avon is liable to flood, and also gets churned up by horses. This path allows walkers an alternative route.

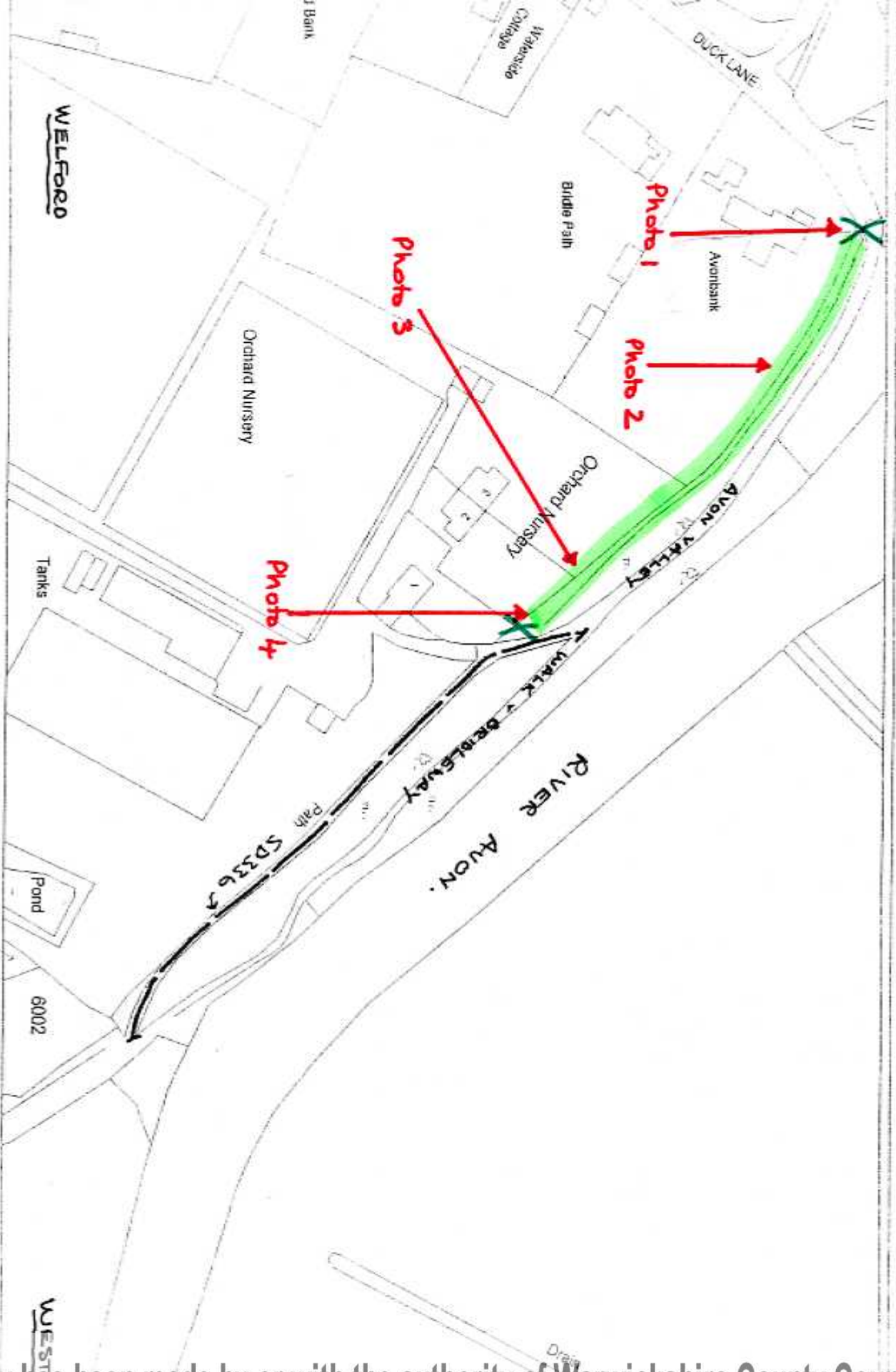
