

Statement of Evidence for Alcester Claim No.3

- This route is first shown on an estate map of Lord Abergovenney of 1804, which is described as being copied from an original of 1776 (County Record Office CR882 + X232). This map shows it as being an integral part of the road network in the area, with no barriers, and dividing that part of the estate, in part, from Shelfield Square Farm.
- 2) It is also shown on all relevant maps of the area, including road maps and the first edition of the Ordnance Survey one inch to one mile map of 1831 (Sheet 51, Worcester).
- 3) It is also shown on all the large scale Ordnance Survey maps up to the present day. This consistent showing of the route confirms that it is has been a substantial, physical, feature since at least the late 18th Century.
- 4) The lane is excluded from the adjoining hereditaments on the 1910 Finance Act map which, it is considered, supports its long standing public nature, as indicated in 1804 (1776).
