Statement of Evidence

- 1) The majority of this route was downgraded to a public footpath by an Order of Quarter Sessions of 26 June 1843 (County Record Office: QS32/2 Mids. 1843). The road to be downgraded was described as being 572 yards long, from the turnpike road from Stratford to Henley in Arden, with the footpath being reserved at 4 feet wide.
- 2) The north end of the remaining section of the claim, from the path to the accepted 'E' road at Burton Farm, is shown on the Order plan and the whole route is referred to in the text as a "highway for horses and carriages" "from or near the village of Bishopton".
- 3) The whole route of the claim is clearly shown on the Ordnance Survey First Series 1/25,000 map, sheet SP15 dated 1952 (1960 reprint).
