Statement of Evidence for RA Claim SD106

- 1) This short link in the path network is first shown on the Inclosure Award of 1857 (County Record Office QS75/115). This created the present SD335 and its continuation south, now known as Cloweswood Lane. The map shows this path creation as linking to the claimed route (going north) and the section of SD276 going west. (SD276 going east was not awarded.)
- 2) The link is also shown, and labelled, on the Deposited Plans for the proposed Birmingham, North Warwickshire and Stratford on Avon Railway 1894 (QS111/477). The plan shows the link as parcel 93, being the continuation of another path, labelled 38, with 93a and 95 (sections of SD276). The Book of Reference lists 93 and 38 as being an occupation road (etc) and public footpath, the owners including the Highways Surveyor. 93a and 95 are listed as "public footpaths" with the owner also being the Highways Surveyor.
- 3) The deposited plans for the GWR Birmingham and North Warwickshire Railway 1908 (QS111/577) actually deal with proposed diversions and closures of paths for the railway. The plan (part sheet 82) shows one path in Clowes Wood being closed and two others being diverted (now forming SD278b). SD276 was also diverted at the railway with the claimed link being shown as the continuation of SD278b from Clowes Wood. (The continuation of SD278b around the north side of Earlswood Lakes is not shown.)
- 4) The claimed route is shown on all large scale Ordnance Survey maps.
- 5) The path is also shown on Sheet 2 of the paths map published by the Ramblers Association, Midland Federation, c.1937 and is well used by the public.

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
