I hereby apply to the Secretary of State under section 66(1) of the Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981, modifying the Definitive Map of Warwickshire, by adding the following route as a

Public Footpath / ~~Public Bridleway~~ / ~~Byway Open To All Traffic~~ *
 as shown on the attached map. IN RED AT 1:2500 SCALE

Please note that when a route starts (from a point on a road or path), the line it follows should be drawn to a scale of 1:2500 on an Ordnance Survey Map and mark the start and finish points on the map. Also indicate the surface type of the route.

This is a section of surfaced access to Hill Farm and Alne Park commencing at the end of County Road D5550, Park Lane, and running for approx 200m. in an easterly direction to link with FP AZ 99

Making your Application

Note on this application form all the documents you are using as evidence (and attach copies if possible), plus any photographs.

Please ask anyone who wishes to give evidence that they have used the route, to fill in a "Witness Statement" Form G. Collect the completed forms and return them with your application.

Before returning your application form you must send to each owner/occupier/tenant of the land crossed by your claim:

- A Notice of Application for Modification order, **(Form A)**

Your completed application form, should then be returned to the County Council with:

- an Ordnance Survey plan of the route
- a certificate of Notice of Application for Modification Order, **(Form B)** listing the owners/occupiers to whom you sent a copy of **(Form A)**.
- Evidence – documents, photographs, "Witness Statement" forms **(Form G)**

You may find it helpful to keep a copy of all the information you send to the County Council.

This section of access road has been walked by generations of villagers and ramblers and casual walkers without any form of objection until notices were received in the Autumn of 1996.

You are already in possession of a number of FORMS G, written statements and a letter from the previous owner who raised no objections to the use of the access by walkers.

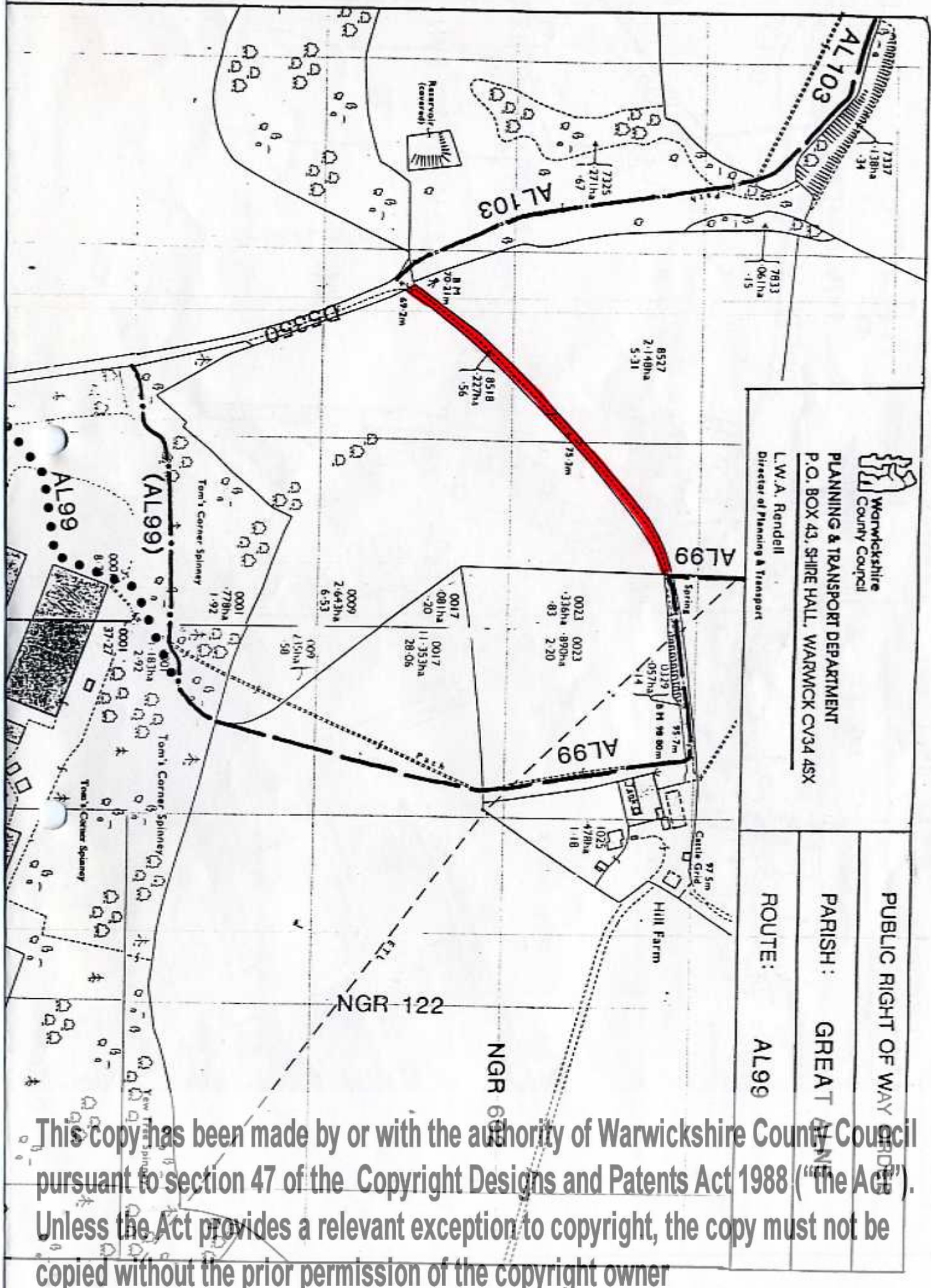
In addition, Mr. J. G. Kalsgrave, area secretary of the Ramblers Association has carried out detailed research in the County Record Office and we think his findings are an important addition to local support.


Mr. Kalsgrave has accompanied a member of the Parish Council to discuss the matter with the landowner - Mr. J. Allen.

The written results of Mr. Kalsgrave's research are attached with his permission.

The Chairman of the Parish Council, Mr. Roger Frewell, and a fellow member of the Council have had two additional meetings with Mr. Allen.

It is felt by the Parish Council that in view of all the evidence submitted to you there is a good case for this section of access road to be designated as a public highway and added to the Definitive Plan as part of the Public Footpath network in the same manner as the remainder of the access road to Hill Farm and Blue Park is Public Footpath, jointly with farm access traffic.
