I hereby apply for an Order under Section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Warwick by **Upgrading** -

in whole / in part \* the route No.<u>W.149</u>........... (as shown on the Definitive Map) SP375E.

from a Public Footpath / Bridleway\*

to a Public bridleway / Byway open to all traffic\* \* \*delete as appropriate

Please describe the route carefully and explain exactly where the route starts (from a point on a road or path), the line it follows and exactly where it finishes. Colour the line of the route on a 1: 2500 scale Ordnance Survey Map and mark the position of any obstructions, fences, stiles or gates. Also note the width and surface type of the route at several points if it varies. If possible give an Ordnance Survey 8 figure grid reference for the start and finish of the route.

W149 on SP37SE from the north it is a continuation of the county road D2226. It continues in a south casterly direction from Grid Ref. 3767 – 7154 for 800 metres to its junction with R336. C.R.F. and the county road D2189 at Grid Ref. 3809 – 7096, then south for a further 750 metres to the county road B4453 at Grid Ref. 3816 7036

The route from Pagets Lune to R336 is a well defined track some 5 metres wide with a hard stone and tarmaced surface through woodland, there is a gate towards the D2226 end. The route from Nunwood Lane to the county road B4453 is again well defined, it is some 5 metres wide, mostly through woodland but with an area with open fields in places. The surface is hard packed stone, overgrown by grass in places. There are four gates along this part of W149.
