Evidence

All references are to documents held by the County Record Office.

1) Background: Beauchamp Road forms part of the 'Emscote' site which was laid out, and was being developed by, Warwick Borough Council. Some plots were sold, for development, to private builders and layout details were determined as the plots came to be developed in Beauchamp Road and Greville Road.

2) Building Plans for 45-75 Beauchamp Road, submitted by Warwick Town Council in November 1924 (CR2487 Boxes 58-67 Plan No.536): nothing shown on site of path to Hill Street (i.e. the gap between 43 and 45 Beauchamp Road).

3) Building Plan for 43 Beauchamp Road, submitted privately in September 1924 (CR2487 Boxes 58-67 Plan No.534) shows house at No. 45 with gap between 43 and 45 labelled as "Reserved for street".

4) Minute Book 1928-9 (CR1618/W22/22):-

Index: Footpath Emscote Housing Estate: Beauchamp Road to Hill Street p.178.

P.178: Highways and Water Cttee 30 September 1929 Minute 253:- attention of cttee drawn to closing to the public of footpath leading across the allotment land at Emscote to the church. The matter was finally left in the hands of the Town Clerk.

[This indicates that the gap between 43 and 45 Beauchamp Road was already in use by the public since the allotments lay on the land to the north of the end of Hill Street, as shown on the Ordnance Survey maps of the time, the only church was All Saints Church on All Saints Road, and there was no other access from Hill Street.]

5) The Ordnance Survey map of 1952 (1/1250 scale) shows, and labels as "FP", the path from the top of Hill Street to Beauchamp Road, adjoining No.45, with steps at two points.

6) The path shown on the above map is shown as adopted/maintainable on the Highway Authority plan kept by the District Council as agents.

7) The path is well used by residents to go to the shops and buses in Emscote Road.

- p. 52 Minute 256 Land corner of Crumple Rd. Lots 1+2 to be sold for share to withdrawal from sale + suitable scheme for improvement to entrance to Eusebio Manning Estate, including newly purchased property 122+125 Crumple Rd to be proposed. Resolved: scheme for improvement to be prepared (Public Health + Manning) after 7 Feb 1930
- p. 54 Minute 270: plan of suggested layout of entrance to Eusebio Manning Estate, including Lots 1+2 and newly purchased 122+125 Crumple Rd submitted. Resolved: same to be withdrawn from sale and special meeting of other to be held (Public Health + Manning) after 10 Feb 1930
- p. 83 Minute 414: letter informed that access from Beachong Rd to Hill St, used by the public over intervening land had recently been closed - considerable inconvenience. Resolved: try to reopen (Ground Companies) after 18 March 1930
- p. 102 Minute 500: re Minute 414 - owner prepared to enter into an agreement with Corporation for a right of way over his land. Resolved: prepare agreement with annual fee
- p. 123 Minute 548. Raily lane. Recent acquisition by Corp. of rights in soil and extinction of commoners' rights now completed - \$50 paid to commoners of St Andrew's Road. Resolved: not to be offered.
- " Minute 600. re Minute 500 - agreement completed for 3 yr term + renewal resolved. requests for purchase by Corporation of the land situated by the right of way referred to Ground Companies after 20 May 1930
- p. 124 Minute 622. plan to proposed improvements to entrance of Crumple Rd and Eusebio's submitted - site visit held on 20th May 1930. To be proposed Crumple Rd and entrance to Eusebio's Estate. Estimated improvement proposed to plan 2 years or so - 1.5+6 ft proposed. Then the ground to be measured to 1904 - a fence will be built for the enclosure - the plan will be shown to Corporation and on that basis an agreement will be made. (Public Health + Manning) after 23 May 1930

p. 127 Minute 750 - entrance to Manning and Lower Manning 20 May 1930
 p. 128 Minute 760 - entrance to Manning and Lower Manning 20 May 1930

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
