Evidence

All references are to documents held by the County Record Office.

1) St Nicholas Inclosure Award 1773 (QS75/123): states that all rights of way are to remain through the (then) St Nicholas Meadow since are not enclosed.

2) Extinguishment Order 1818 (CR1618/W7/46 + articles in The Warwick Advertiser): attempt to close this route, but not confirmed due to errors in the lengths and described as one path with two entrances on to St Nicholas Church Street.

3) Deposited railway plans QS111/200, /199 + /196 all show route, but are not within scheduled area and, therefore, are not listed in Books of Reference

4) Board of Health Map 1851: shows whole path, with branch

5) Corporation Minutes 1902-1905 (CR1618/W22/14 p.467): states that footpath through St Nicholas Churchyard to be repaired by the Council (Streets Committee Report to Council 10 October 1905). This confirms highway status since liability to maintain accepted by Council.

6) Land for St Nicholas Park acquired under Warwick Corporation Act 1928 (18+19 George V Chapter 35)

7) Plan of proposed park formally deposited with Clerk of the Peace 30 November 1927 (QS111/628(part)): shows park area, with paths and ownership boundary. Based on OS map.

8) Route, with branch, shown as adopted/maintainable on Highway Authority plans.
