## Evidence

All references are to documents held by the County Record Office.

- 1) 1786 Estate map of Warwick (CR1886/M32): east part shown as a track from Stratford Road, between hedges, going in to a field and then west along edge of field.
- 2) Estate map of c.1802 (CR237/89/1) shows end of path from West Street/Stratford Road as it emerges into field called "Lower Fryers" with gate onto Gog Lane (now Hampton Road) at the other end of the field.
- 3) Plan of 1831, with deed (CR237/99/1+2): plan labels "foot road" as an abuttal to one plot; deed refers to it as "footpath leading out of the Hampton Road to or towards West Street".
- 4) deeds of 1830-1833 (CR237/188/1-3): describe same abuttal as "foot road leading from Hampton Road into West Street".
- 5) Tracing of map of 1837 (CR1618/W6/23): whole of path shown and labelled as "Foot Road".
- 6) Tithe Map 1848 (CR569/252): part off West Street shown coloured (wrongly: blue as if it was a stream!) as separate piece of land (not titheable) with pecked line adjoining it and continuing in to field to west (field not numbered and, therefore, not titheable presumably since built on). Land not titheable, and not developed, is normally land which is waste, such as a highway.
- 7) 1851 Board of Health map (published by the County Council in a teaching archive): labells route as "Lower Friars" and shows spot heights + symbol/label as boundary of St Pauls parish along route.
- 8) Plan of Commonable Lands of St Marys 1874 (CR1618/WA16/1/33): shows north-west end of route (not labelled) coloured in same way as other roads.
- 9) Diversion Order (confirmed 25/8/1971) moved central section (now called WB22 on Definitive Map) onto new service road. [This diversion confirms that the whole route is public since there were no other routes linking to it.]
- 10) The section off West Street contains an old, standard, Highway Authority street map post, which could not have been installed without the then Council believing the route to be a public highway since they would have had no other powers to install it.
- N.B. Form B is not included since the owners of these two sections of this original path are not known.
