Description : Route A to X - on Plan - HHRA 1a/09

The Route commences at point A on plan on the eastern boundary of the Hockley Heath Recreation Ground. For over two decades, a substantial single wooden plank footbridge, about 15" wide and firmly embedded, spanned the wide ditch course.

(This bridge was removed and the new land owner obstructed access by large amounts of barbed wire)

Crossing the ditch the route enters directly to the adjoining farmland through what was an unobstructed gap in the hedgerow/fence.

The once well used path runs along what was a wide unploughed grass verge. It follows the field boundary, first northwards for a few yards, and then eastwards, as shown on the plan.

At B on plan, the path meets the statutory footpath SL42 at a track, and continues free of obstruction to join another well trod unploughed grass verge running eastward, again alongside a field boundary to the point X on plan, where the statutory path SL41 is joined.
