Statement of Evidence for the Path from L11 (by Rawnsley Road, Learnington Spa) (SP328667) across Taylor Avenue, to Valley Road (SP326669)

1) The whole of this route (with L11) was the subject of a Diversion Order in 1933 (see QS47/334 held by the County Record Office). Quarter Sessions refused to confirm (i.e. enroll) the Justices application as the diversion route already existed. This confirms that the route was public and, since there have been no other Orders relating to this section, it still exists.

2) The path was retained and improved when the Taylor Avenue/Gresham Avenue development was built, as shown on Building Plans CR2487/699, /735 and /749 held by the County Record Office.

3) CR2487/735 is a layout plan and labels this route as 'FP' at each end with a continuation arrow. It is labelled "Footpath maintained 5 feet wide".

4) CR2487/749 is an application, with plans and notices, for the roads and sewers and shows this path coloured, as all the estate roads and other paths. This route is labelled "Public Footpath 5' 0" wide" and the plan is stamped "approved" 13 January 1936.

5) The District Council, as agents for the Highway Authority, accepted on 12 June 1997 that the above approval was the adoption of the coloured routes shown thereon.

6) The route is shown as being publically maintainable on the list of maintainable highways map kept by the District Council as agents.

7) This path is also the continuation of path L11, which is already shown on the Definitive Map due to a, more recent, diversion of that section of the path.

8) This route should therefore be added to the Definitive Map as a 'legal event'.
