I hereby apply for an Order under Section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Warwick by **Adding** the following route as a -

Public Footpath / Public Bridleway / Byway Open to All Traffic*

Please describe the route carefully and explain exactly where the route starts (from a point on a road or path), the line it follows and exactly where it finishes. Colour the line of the route on a 1: 2500 scale Ordnance Survey Map and mark the position of any obstructions, fences, stiles or pates. Also note the width and surface type of the route at several points if it varies. If possible give an Ordnance Survey 8 figure grid reference for the start and finish of the route.

Access to this walk is at the north corner of the Recreation Ground [A] by the cricket nets. This leads into the woods behind Waller Close. From here the walk curves initially northwest, then west and southwest following a mud path through the woods approximately 1metre wide, leading to what is now a gate alongside Woodcote Lane and to the east of North Lodge. This gate was previously a large gap in the hedge.

Woodcote Lane is then crossed to a gap in the hedge, now closed, which many years ago was a stile, leading onto the eastern edge of the football field at the Police Headquarters. The eastern edge of the football field is followed to bring the walk to a <u>stile</u> which leads onto the road to the Police Headquarters.

Turning to the right, west, for approximately 10 metres the walk then joins an existing Public Footpath W179A at what is now a gate, but was previously a stile IB1 Turning to the walk continues onto Woodcote Drive [C].
