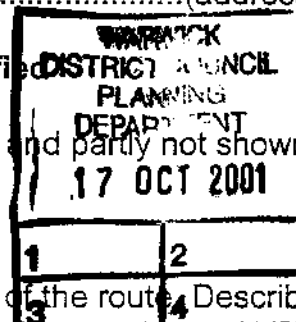

**There is no need for you to do anything at this time.** You will be contacted as soon as the County Council begin their investigation. You will have the right to see the evidence in support of the claim and comment on it before any decision is taken.

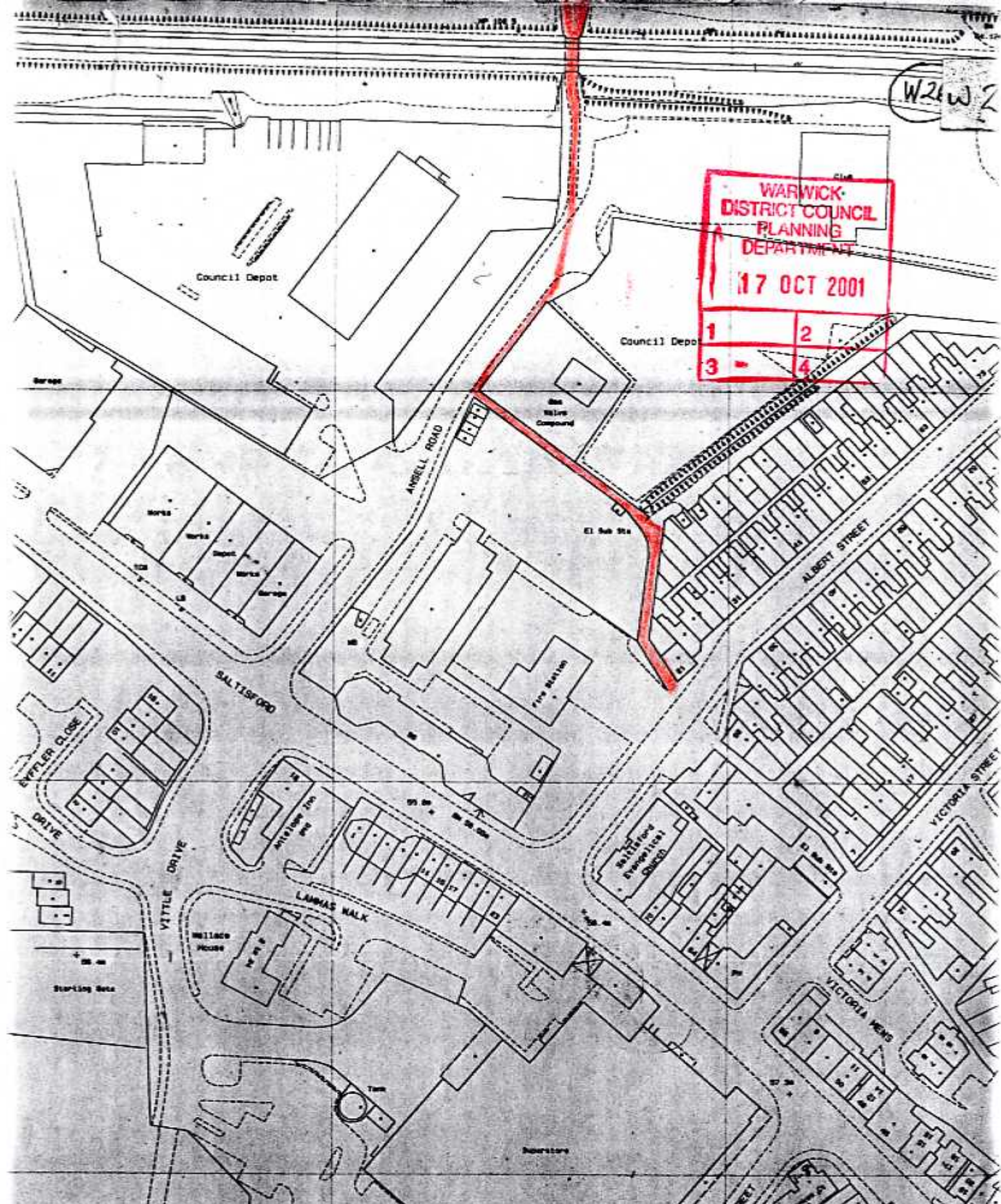
