### Statement of Evidence

- 1) The route is, in origin, an ancient path known as Beggars Path or Beggars Path Lane in the 16th and 17th Centuries.
- 2) The 1841 Warwick and Learnington Branch Railway deposited railway plan (County Record Office ref. QS111/129/1+4) shows, and labels, field 46 as "arable, pit and footpath".
- 3) The first edition one inch Ordnance Survey map (with the railway added) shows the path as crossing the railway.
- 4) The route is shown on all large scale Ordnance Survey maps.
- 5) The Tithe Apportionment Map of 1849 (County Record Office ref. CR569/139) shows and labels the section east from the railway as "footpath".
- 6) The Board of Health map of c.1877 shows this path and labels it as "footpath to station".
- 7) The section from the west side of the railway to Waverley Road was created by a Diversion Order (County Record Office ref. QS47/144) and confirmed as having been made on 17/10/1885. This section is shown on the present Definitive Map as K36.
- 8) The area to the east of the railway was developed in the 1960's with the remaining section of the path, from Farmer Ward Road to the east side of the railway (the boundary of the former excluded area), being shown on the Definitive Map as footpath K23.
- 9) This claim is for the remaining section of the path in the former excluded area, namely the section over the footbridge over the railway between K23 and K36.
