Statement of Evidence

- 1) The route from Borrowell Lane south-east to Roseland Road (including path K17 and the original line of K33) has its origin as the rear access to the 11th Century newtown founded on the south-west side of the present Square/Warwick Road. (See Kenilworth 1086-1756 by S. G. Wallsgrove)
- 2) The K17 part is described in an Extent of 1591 as "Barrow Lane" (County Record Office ref. CR576/1: 84th free tenant), with the sections to the south being called Barrow Field Lane, Fennyland Lane, and Buckingtons Lane.
- 3) The Estate Map of 1692 (County Record Office ref. CR143/1) shows the south end, by St Johns Street, and labels it as "Fennyland Lane".
- 4) The Board of Health Map of c.1877 labels the part by Barrow Road as "footpath".
- 5) The route is shown, and labelled, on all large scale Ordnance Survey maps
- 6) The whole route, including K17 and K33, has a well maintained tarmac surface with street lights and 'no cycling' notices.
- 7) The whole route is shown on the map of the list of streets kept by the District Council as agents for the Highway Authority as a route maintainable at public expense.
- 8) The whole route is well used by the public.
- 9) It is considered, therefore, that this evidence shows that the parts of this ancient route not recorded as a public path are part of a single route with K17 and K33.
